Board Highlights - June 7, 2016

Strategic Planning

The Board reviewed the draft strategic plan and goal statements, developed based on the Board's strategic planning session held on April 4, 2016.

The four draft strategic priorities reviewed were:

1. Develop the profession's capacity to meet the future needs of Manitobans.
2. Support Manitobans' access to quality health care by addressing barriers to full scope of practice.
3. Enhance effective self-regulation.
4. Strengthen engagement and collaboration with stakeholders to achieve all strategic priorities.

The Board approved the strategic priority statements and goals, as presented, and adopted them as the CLPNM Strategic Plan for June 2016 until June 2019.

The Board reviewed the current vision and mission statements and determined that no changes would be made.
