All sites, facilities and settings have precautions and safety measures in place, including:.

- Daily staff screening;
- Universal Personal Protective Equipment appropriate to the setting and task;
- Enhancing environmental cleaning and disinfection including frequency of cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces and equipment;
- Limited visitation and visitor screening
- PCHs with confirmed staff or resident cases of COVID-19 also have additional precautions in place according to outbreak protocols.

Due to the demand and nature of some work, assignments requiring intensive training will require a minimum EFT and time commitment. This includes assignments to Health Links – Info Santé.
