Opportunities for Nursing and Allied Health Students:

- Did you know, you can work as an HCA or Recreation Worker provided certain educational requirements are met?
- Nursing and Allied Health Students who are not qualified to work as an HCA or RA may assist Recreational Workers in PCHs supporting important activities that keep residents socially and physically active

Opportunities for All Health Care Students:

- Students from a variety of health care education backgrounds can provide necessary support in the following areas within Personal Care Homes (PCHs):
 - Assist with mealtime set up.
 - Feeding support for some PCH residents (with the exception of those with known swallowing disorders and requiring special feeding techniques).
 - Provide psycho-social supports to families; assistance with resident and family support, connecting with families and arranging in-person and/or face time visits.
 - In the event of a positive COVID-19 case and/or outbreak, students can assist in contacting families/community with updates (a script would be provided).
- Provide assistance with enhanced cleaning requirements
- Entry level screening at facilities.
- Arranging fit-testing for health care workers.

Pay will be based on individual positions and individual skills and qualifications with a range from \$14.00 to \$18.00 per hour.
